



Composition

Buparvaquone 50 mg Excipients up to 1 ml.

Target species

Cattle

Indications

Butakel is indicated for the treatment of theileriosis (East Coast fever, Corridor Disease) in cattle caused by *Theileria parva parva*, *Theileria parva bovis*, *Theileria parva Lawrencei*, *Theileria annulata*, *Theileria mutans* and *Theileria o rientalis sergenti*.

Buparvaquone is an hydroxynaphthoquinone, active against the schizont and piroplasm stages of *Theileria spp.* It can be used for treatment of clinically sick animals but also for prevention during incubation in all in-contact animals before showing clinical signs.

Dosage and administration

By intramuscular injection.

2.5 mg/kg body weight or 1 ml Butakel per 20 kg body weight.

In severe cases a second identical dose may be injected 48-72 hours after the first injection. Normal aseptic precautions should be taken. If more than 10 ml is to be injected, the total volume should be divided over two injection sites, one on each side of the neck.
