Composition

One injector contains: Neomycin sulphate 500 000 I.U. Procaine benzylpenicillin 300 000 I.U. Excipients up to 10 g.

Target species

Lactating cattle

Indications

Treatment of mastitis caused by microorganisms susceptible to penicillin and/or neomycin.

Dosage and administration

Before infusion, the udder should be milked out completely. The teat and its orifice should be thoroughly cleaned. The contents of one syringe should be infused into each affected quarter via the teat canal, immediately after milking.

Dosage:

Cow: 1 injector per infected quarter

If necessary repeat once or twice with an interval of 12 hours.
